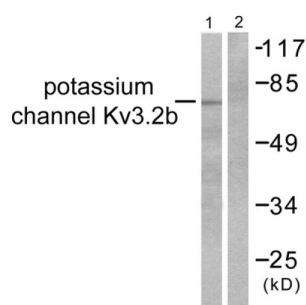
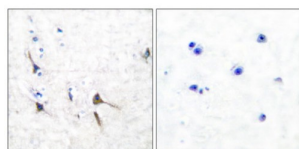

Recommended dilutions: WB: 1/500 - 1/3000, IHC: 1/50 - 1/100, ELISA: 1/10000. Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

Immunogen: The antiserum was produced against synthesized peptide derived from C-terminal of human Potassium Channel Kv3.2b.

Isotype: IgG

Form: Liquid

Purification: Purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.
