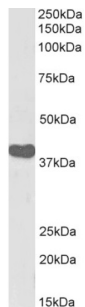


ILF2 Antibody (Biotin)

Western blot analysis of Human Tonsil lysate (35 µg protein in RIPA buffer) using biotin-conjugated ILF2 Antibody (0.1 µg/ml, 1 hour). Detected by chemiluminescence, using streptavidin-HRP and using NAP blocker as a substitute for skimmed milk.

ILF2 Antibody is a Goat Polyclonal antibody against ILF2 ([abx430157](#)) conjugated to biotin.

Target: ILF2

Clonality: Polyclonal

Reactivity: Human

Tested Applications: P-ELISA, WB

Host: Goat

Recommended dilutions: P-ELISA: 1/16000. Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

Conjugation: Biotin

Immunogen: Internal region (near the C-Terminus): C-EKAYEKPPEKKEG

Isotype: IgG

Form: Liquid

Purification: Purified from goat serum by ammonium sulphate precipitation followed by antigen affinity chromatography using the immunizing peptide.

Storage: Aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
