

	though please note that this will change the overall salt concentration. The stock concentration should be between 0.1-1.0 mg/ml. Do not vortex.
Storage:	Store at 2-8 °C for up to one month. Store at -80 °C for up to one year. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw
	cycles.
