to-lot consistency.

Storage: Shipped at 4 °C. Store at -20 °C for up to one year.

Directions for use: 1. Before resuspending, briefly centrifuge the tube to ensure the lyophilized miRNA is at the bottom

of the tube.

2. Resuspend the miRNA oligos to an appropriate concentration with DEPC water (e.g. resuspend

one vial of 5 nmol miRNA oligo in 250 μl of DEPC water for a final concentration of 20 μM).
