Storage:	Shipped at 4 °C. Upon receipt, store the kit according to the storage instruction in the kit's manual.
Validity:	The validity for this kit is 6 months.
Stability:	The stability of the kit is determined by the rate of activity loss. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage conditions. To minimize performance fluctuations, operation procedures and lab conditions should be strictly controlled. It is also strongly suggested that the whole assay is performed by the same user throughout.

Assay Procedure:	<ul> <li>This procedure is provided for reference only. The product manual may differ slightly. The product should be used as stated on the product manual included and delivered together with the product.</li> <li>1) Set standard, test samples and control wells.</li> <li>2) Aliquot 100 µl of diluted standard into the standard wells.</li> <li>3) Aliquot 100 µl of Standard Diluent buffer into control (zero) well.</li> <li>4) Aliquot 100 µl of diluted samples into the sample wells. Incubate for 1 hr at 37 °C.</li> <li>5) Aliquot 100 µl of Detection Reagent A to each well. Incubate for 1 hr at 37 °C.</li> <li>6) Wash 3 times.</li> <li>7) Aliquot 100 µl of Detection Reagent B to each well. Incubate for 30 mins at 37 °C.</li> <li>8) Wash 5 times.</li> <li>9) Aliquot 90 µl of TMB Substrate to each well. Incubate for 10-20 mins at 37 °C.</li> <li>10) Aliquot 50 µl of Stop Solution.</li> <li>11) Measure the OD at 450 nm.</li> </ul>
Protocol:	<ul> <li>This procedure is provided for reference only. The product manual may differ slightly. The product should be used as stated on the product manual included and delivered together with the product.</li> <li>Equilibrate the kit components and samples to room temperature (18 - 25 °C) before use. It is recommended to plot a standard curve for each test.</li> <li>1. Set standard, test sample and control (zero) wells on the pre-coated plate respectively, and then, record their positions. It is recommended to measure each standard and sample at least in duplicate.</li> <li>2. Add 100 µL of each standard, control and sample into the appropriate wells. Seal the plate with a cover and incubate for 1 h at 37°C.</li> <li>3. Remove the cover and discard the liquid.</li> <li>4. Add 100 µL of be detection Reagent A working solution to each well. Seal the plate with a cover and incubate for 1 h at 37°C.</li> <li>5. Remove the cover and discard the solution. Wash the plate 3 times with 1X Wash Buffer.</li> <li>6. Add 100 µL of Detection Reagent B working solution into each well, seal and incubate at 37°C for 30 min.</li> <li>7. Discard the solution and wash the plate 5 times with wash buffer as explained in previous step.</li> <li>8. Aliquot 90 µL of TMB Substrate into each well. Seal the plate with a cover and incubate at 37°C for 10-20 min. Avoid exposure to light. The incubation time is for reference use only, the optimal time should be determined by end user. Do not exceed 30 min.</li> </ul>
Results Calculation:	<ul> <li>9. Add 50 µL of Stop Solution to each well. Read at 450 nm immediately.</li> <li>For calculation, average the O.D.450 duplicate readings for each reference standard and each sample and substract the average control (zero) O.D.450 reading. The standard curve can be plotted as the relative O.D.450 of each reference standard solution (Y) vs. the respective concentration of each standard solution (X). The LPAR4 concentration of the samples can be interpolated from the standard curve.</li> </ul>
